### **Parent/Legal Guardian Consent**

Safety is one of Nebo School District's greatest concerns. Reasonable efforts are made to help make school safe. However, participation in CTE classes carries with it certain unavoidable, unpredictable, and inherent risks and dangers that no amount of care, caution, or instruction can eliminate.

The tools and equipment used in a CTE class can range from basic hand tools like scissors, hammers, and screwdrivers to advanced power tools and equipment for higher level classes.
